From the world's point of view most of us are not very important. Some of us have enjoyed some degree of success in our professions, and maybe we are somewhat important where we work, but for the most part the world does not really recognize us as important. From religion's or religious people's point of view we are unworthy or even worthless, and if we grovel and suffer and beg maybe God may notice us a little. That is not what God thinks of us. To God we are very important, we are precious, and priceless. God has waited for all eternity to have fellowship with His sons. God thought so much of us that He sent Jesus Christ to die for us, and He raised him from the dead and gave us the gift of holy spirit and eternal life.

**Romans 5:7** For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would dare to die.

**5:8** But God commendeth his love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

**Ephesians 1:4** According as he [God] hath chosen us in him [Jesus Christ] before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

God thought so much of us that He sent his son to be our sin sacrifice, and God chose us before the foundation of the world and He made us holy and without blame before Him in love.

*I John 3:1* Behold what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

11:13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

*I John 1:5b* God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

If we being imperfect give good gifts to our children, then how can God Almighty do less for His sons? When the world says that we are unimportant, they only show their ignorance of God and His Word. When religion says that we are unimportant and worthless, they contradict God's Word and attribute darkness and evil to God. God is not capable of doing evil and He is Light, not darkness.

*II Corinthians 5:18* And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

**5:19** To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

**5:20** Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead be ye reconciled to God.

We are God's ambassadors sent to deliver a message, the Word of God. Anyone who is an ambassador for God and Christ has to be very important; the ambassador represents God and Jesus Christ in this world. God has committed unto His ambassadors the word of reconciliation, and He has given us the ministry of reconciliation. In this day and time God has given us the responsibility and ability of reconciling man to God. Obviously He must have a very high opinion of us.

#### **Proverbs 13:17b** a faithful ambassador is health.

**Philippians 4:19** But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

*Philippians 4:13* I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

**Romans 8:37** Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

God wants us to have a life which is more than abundant. He wants us to be in health and prosper. God promises to supply all of our needs. He says we can do all things through Christ, and He says that we are more than conquerors.
